What is Re-AI?

Low-skilled adults face significant challenges in adapting to the rapidly evolving digital job market – especially in remote and hybrid work environments. A lack of AI literacy and basic digital skills limits their employability and career advancement opportunities.

The **Re-AI project** (2025-1-PT01-KA210-VET-000355303) aims to enhance AI literacy and digital skills among low-skilled adults, enabling them to effectively transition into remote and hybrid work environments. Running from September 2025 to February 2027, Re-AI is co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.



Equip low-skilled adults with essential AI & digital competencies for remote work



Develop practicals easy-to-follow learning modules with hands-on exercises



Train VET educators to effectively deliver the Re-AI methodology



Launch an online platform with training modules, exercises, and a resource library
