

The RemoteHeR Project

The Erasmus+ VET project RemoteHeR started in November 2025 and runs until July 2027.

RemoteHeR aims to empower women, especially vulnerable groups such as mothers and migrants, to build independent careers in digital and remote human resources. It focuses on developing a training curriculum that combines HR skills with digital and remote-work competencies. The project includes training for trainers so women can learn and teach independently. All materials will be made freely available as open educational resources on a dedicated website, promoting inclusion, gender equality, and sustainable access to vocational education across Europe.

Portugal, Spain, Estonia, and Germany each bring distinct strengths to RemoteHeR: regional development and innovation (PT), gender-equality and women's rights expertise (ES), digital-skills and VET innovation (EE), and academic research and evaluation capacity (DE). Together, they form a balanced consortium that supports women's access to digital and remote HR careers across Europe. The working language of RemoteHeR is English.

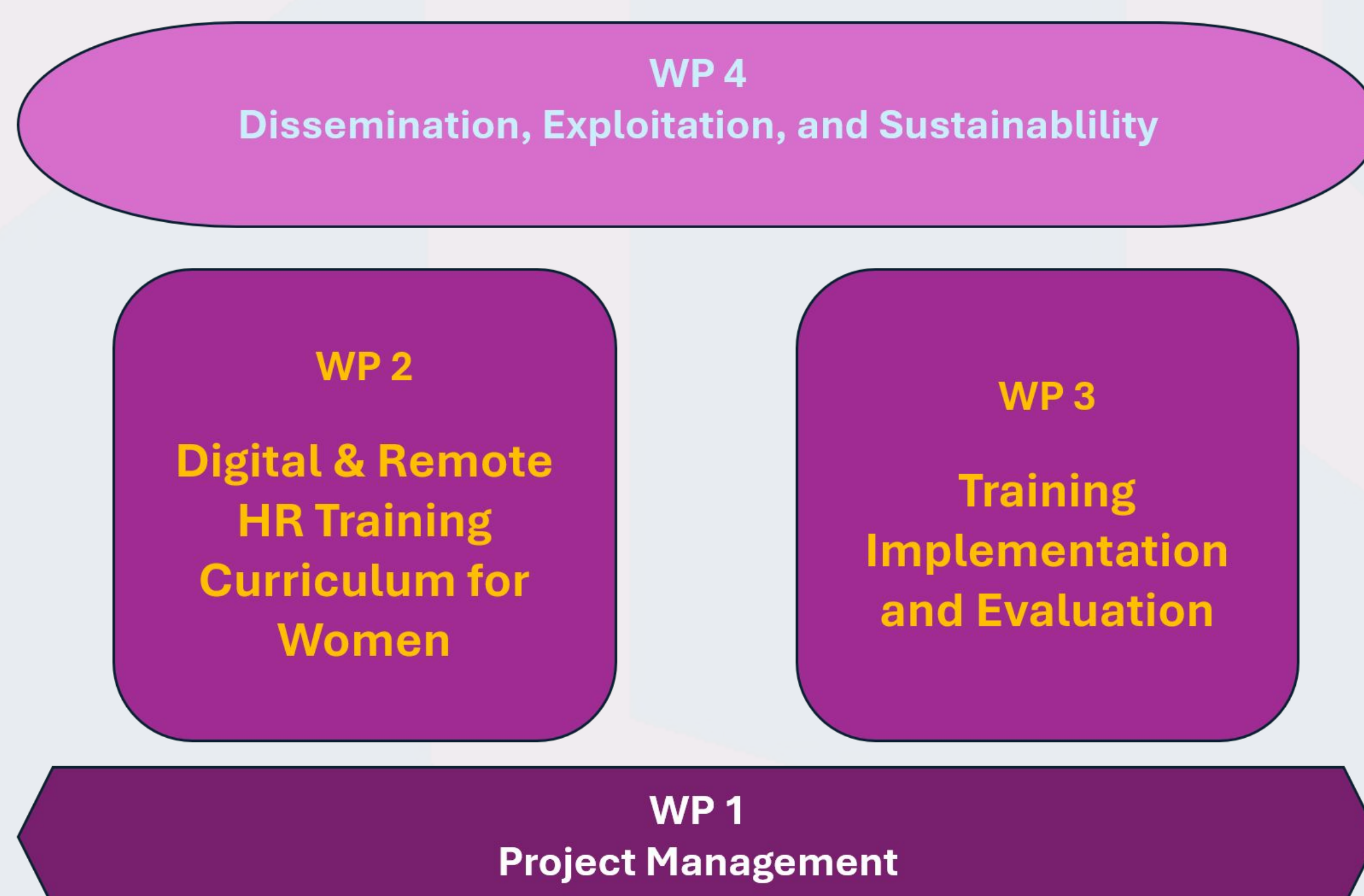
